



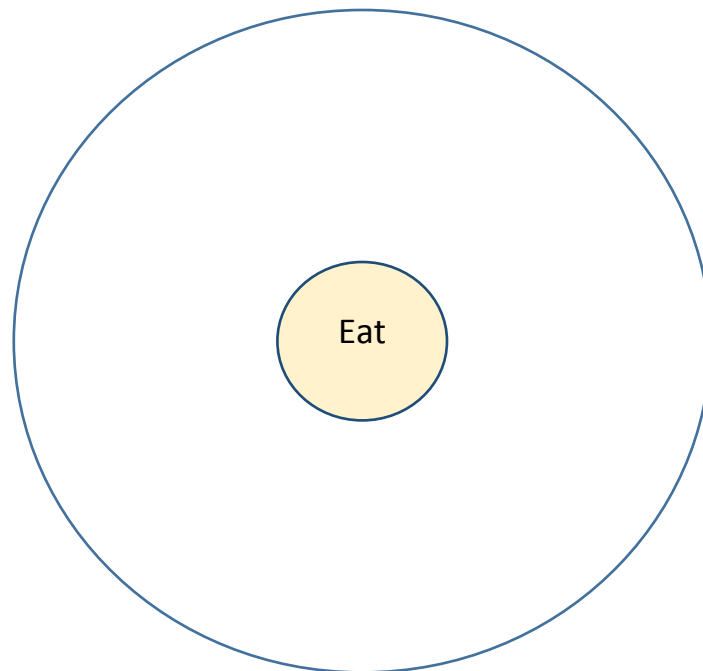
Build Your English Vocabulary
