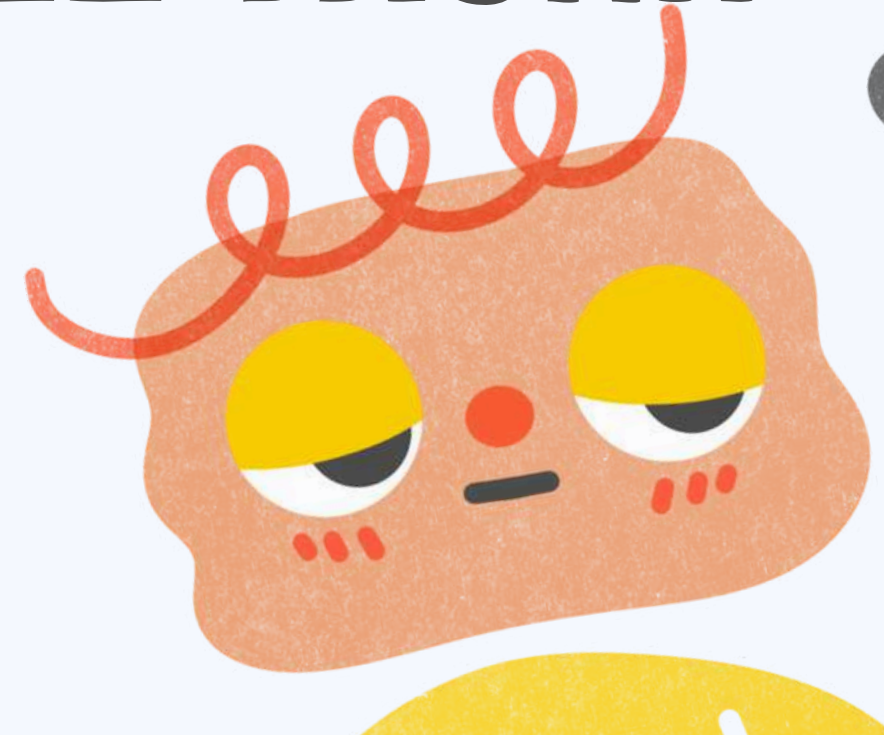

The fox was very sad and upset. He told himself, "I wish I had thought a little before jumping into the hole."

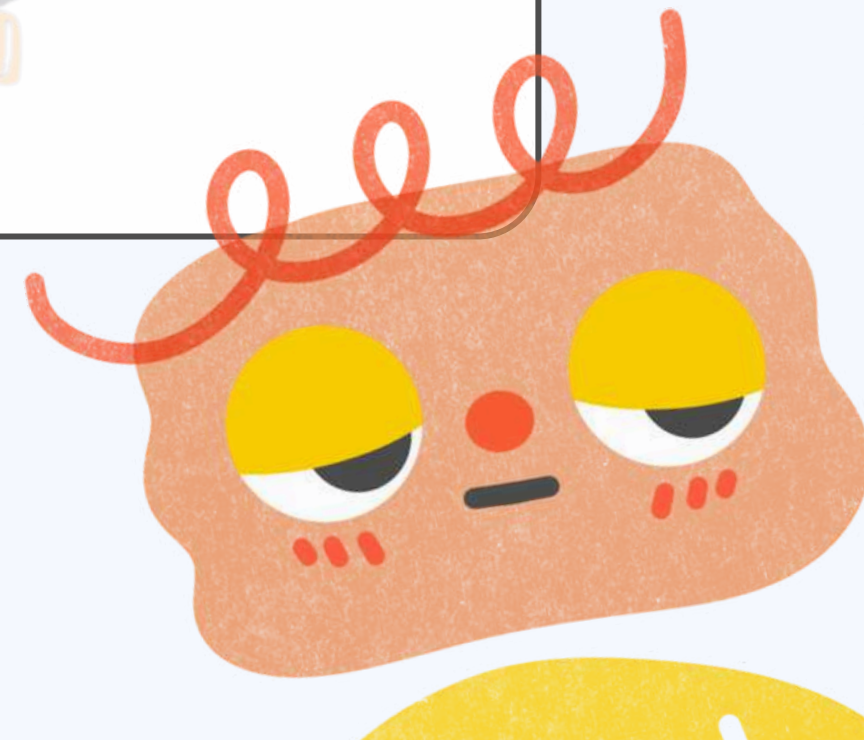
Yes children, this is the result of doing something without thinking about it first.
